At its most basic level, public economics provides a framework for thinking about whether or not the government should take part in economic markets and to what extent it should do so. In industrialized countries, the public sector accounts for more than one third of all economic activities. The government affects almost everything that we do in our daily life. This course employs tools pf</p>							

	microeconomic analysis to study the role of the government in the economy. Special emphasis is on current public policy issues such as rising inequality, poverty, health care reform, income tax reform, and budget deficits						
선수과목 및 지식 Prerequisite	<b>Intermediate Microeconomics</b> is a prerequisite for this course. Having this prerequisite is very critical since we will directly build on the concepts that you have already learned in <b>Intermediate Microeconomics</b> . Even though reviewing some important concepts in class during the semester, I will not spend enough time covering them in detail. As illustration, I assume that you are comfortable with multivariate calculus as well as univariate calculus (calculus in one variable).
